PROPOSALS for the construction of **BASIN - K SEWER REHABILITATION** will be received by Newport Utilities at the offices of **HYDROSTRUCTURES, now affiliated with DUKE'S** until **Tuesday 2:00 PM EST, May 20, 2025.** **This project is being supported with the American Rescue Plan Act (ARPA), Coronavirus State and Local Fiscal Recovery Fund (SLFRF) Grant Program and is administered through the TDEC State Water Infrastructure Grants (SWG) agency. Therefore, certain restrictions and other federal requirements are attached to this opportunity.** The work consists of mainline repairs on the gravity sewer collection system at Cocke County, Tennessee. The work includes the following approximate major items:

- Installation of ~10,000 linear feet of 8-inch Cured-in-Place Pipe Liner.
- Pipe Bursting of ~5,000 linear feet of pipe.
- ~650 Vertical Feet of Cementitious Liner.
- Miscellaneous construction activities including excavation and backfill, asphalt pavement removal and replacement, site restoration, flow control and bypass pumping, traffic control, etc.

# **INFORMATION FOR BIDDERS**

PROPOSALS will be received by Newport Utilities (herein called the "OWNER"), until Tuesday May 20, 2025 - 2:00 PM EST.

Newport Utilities is accepting proposals/bids for a NEWPORT BASIN-K SEWER REHABILITATION. Prospective bidders are invited to a in person or virtual (Microsoft Teams and or conference call) pre-proposal/bid meeting at the NU Operation Center Auditorium, 1419 W Highway 25-70, Newport, TN 37821 on **Tuesday, May 06, 2025, at 2:00 PM local time**. Attendance is required for proposal to be accepted. You may access the RFP at [www.newportutilities.com](http://www.newportutilities.com).

PROPOSALS should be delivered to the office of the Engineer: Hydrostructures, now affiliated with DUKE'S, 126 Commerce Court (P.O. Box 1537), Pittsboro, North Carolina 27312 or shall be received by the bid closing date and time to the following email address [lfarrar@dukes.com](mailto:lfarrar@dukes.com) with subject line NEWPORT BASIN - K SEWER REHABILITATION. Hydrostructures will provide confirmation that the bid proposal was received within the deadline.

All PROPOSALS must be made on the required form. All blank spaces for PROPOSAL prices must be filled in, in ink or typewritten, and the form must be fully completed and executed when submitted. Only one copy of the PROPOSAL FORM is required.

Each BIDDER **shall submit three (3) specific references** of work similar in scope and nature to this project. The information provided shall include a brief description of the work and quantity of work performed as well as the name, title, address and telephone number of the individual who was representative of the client and in responsible charge of each project. Each bidder shall also include a list of all subcontractors to be used on the project and the specific task they will perform.

Each BIDDER must provide and maintain a drug free workplace, including certification, in accordance with the Federal Drug Free Workplace Act of 1988 (40 CFR Part 32).

The OWNER may waive any informalities or minor defects or reject any and all PROPOSALS. Any PROPOSAL may be withdrawn prior to the above scheduled time for the opening of PROPOSALS or authorized postponement thereof. Any PROPOSAL received after the time and date specified shall not be considered. No BIDDER may withdraw a PROPOSAL within 30 days after the actual date of the opening thereof. Should there be reasons why the contract cannot be awarded within the specified period, the time may be extended by mutual agreement between the OWNER and BIDDER.

BIDDERS must satisfy themselves of the accuracy of the estimated quantities in the PROPOSAL Schedule by examination of the site and a review of the drawings and specifications including ADDENDA. After PROPOSALS have been submitted, the BIDDER shall not assert that there was a misunderstanding concerning the quantities of WORK or of the nature of the WORK to be done.

Information and data shown or indicated in the Contract Documents with respect to underground utilities at or contiguous to the project site is based upon information provided by the owners of such utilities or others, and the OWNER and ENGINEER do not assume responsibility for the accuracy and completeness thereof.

The OWNER shall provide to BIDDERS prior to BIDDING, all information that is pertinent to, and delineates and describes, the land owned and rights-of-way acquired or to be acquired. All additional lands and access thereto required for temporary construction facilities, construction equipment, or storage of materials and equipment are to be obtained and paid for by the CONTRACTOR.

The CONTRACT DOCUMENTS contain the provisions required for the construction of the PROJECT. Information obtained from an officer, agent, or employee of the OWNER or any other person shall not affect the risks or obligations assumed by the CONTRACTOR or relieve him from fulfilling any of the conditions of

the contract. All questions about the meaning or intent of the CONTRACT DOCUMENTS are to be directed to the ENGINEER. Interpretations or clarifications considered necessary by the ENGINEER shall be issued by Addenda to be **e-mailed** to all plan holders. Questions received less than 2 days before the PROPOSAL opening may not be answered. Only questions answered by written formal Addenda will be binding. Oral or other interpretations or clarifications shall be without legal effect.

A Performance BOND and Payment BOND, each in the amount of 100 percent of the CONTRACT PRICE, with a corporate surety approved by the OWNER, will be required for the faithful performance of the contract.

Attorneys-in-fact who sign Payment BONDS and Performance BONDS must file with each BOND a certified and effective dated copy of their power of attorney.

The party to whom the Contract is awarded will be required to execute the Agreement and obtain the Performance BOND and Payment BOND within ten (10) calendar days from the date when the NOTICE OF AWARD is delivered to the BIDDER. The NOTICE OF AWARD shall be accompanied by the necessary AGREEMENT and BOND forms.

The OWNER may make such investigations as he deems necessary to determine the ability of the BIDDER to perform the WORK, and the BIDDER shall furnish to the OWNER all such information and data for this purpose as the OWNER may request within 5 days of the PROPOSAL Opening. The OWNER reserves the right to reject any PROPOSAL if the evidence submitted by, or investigation of, such BIDDER fails to satisfy the OWNER that such BIDDER is properly qualified to carry out the obligations of the Agreement and to complete the WORK contemplated therein.

A conditional or qualified PROPOSAL will not be accepted.

Award may be made to the lowest responsive, responsible BIDDER.

All applicable laws, ordinances, and the rules and regulations of all authorities having jurisdiction over construction of the PROJECT shall apply to the Contract throughout.

Each BIDDER is responsible for inspecting the site and for reading and being thoroughly familiar with the CONTRACT DOCUMENTS. The failure or omission of any BIDDER to do any of the foregoing shall in no way relieve any BIDDER from any obligation in respect to his PROPOSAL.

The low BIDDER must supply the names and addresses of major material suppliers and subcontractors when requested to do so by the OWNER.
