- A temporary drop in water pressure to your residence or place of business
- Rusty ,brown or cloudy water (These conditions will subside after flushing is complete)
- Avoid doing laundry during flushing operations

After flushing operation is complete:

- Open a cold-water facet and let water flow until clear. (When available use an outside spigot
